



Volunteer Position: Women's Street Market Job Description

The volunteer assists in creating a safe and friendly environment at the Summer Street Market and help organize the event to ensure it runs smoothly. They are responsible for the safety of the vendors and customers at the market, as well as assist with the market set up and take down. Some responsibilities are:

- Market set up: Place road barricades up, move market supplies from the center and unpack, and decorate the market to give it an alluring appeal
- Observe events and people at the market. Create a safe, fun and inviting environment. Help deescalate conflicts and unsafe activities.
- Distribute food and community service goods to customers.
- Market Tear Down: Pack up all market supplies and return to the centre after the market is done.
- This job does requiring lifting and moving items.
- Communicating any comments, concerns or feedback to the Street Market Coordinator.
